“Sex and the City” replaces postponed “Mamma Mia”

The next showing at the Liphook Millennium Centre Cinema in Liphook will be “Sex and the City” on Friday 7 November at 8.00pm, which is replacing the planned double showing of Mamma Mia over the same weekend.

The showing of “Mamma Mia” has been postponed due to a security breach on a non-theatrical copy of “Mamma Mia” which has resulted in the DVD being withdrawn until 24 November. “Mamma Mia” has been re-booked for showings on Friday 12 December at 8.00pm and Sunday 14 December at 3.00pm. “We are deeply disappointed that we are unable to show “Mamma Mia”, but the situation is beyond our control” said Councillor John Tough, who organises the cinema on behalf of the Parish Council. “Anybody with tickets can have a full and immediate refund, exchange their tickets for the showing of “Sex and the City” on Friday 7 November or for either showing of “Mamma Mia” on Friday 12 December and Sunday 14 December. The original tickets will have to be presented at the Liphook Millennium Hall or the Parish Office in Liphook for a refund or any exchange” he added.

Impressive performances by the four leading ladies, makes “Sex and the City” both watchable and entertaining. Carrie (Sarah Jessica Parker) moves in to a glorious apartment with Mr Big and ponders whether or not to get married. Samantha (Kim Cattrall) relocates to LA to promote the acting career of her dazzling young beau. Miranda (Cynthia Nixon) confronts a serious rift in her marriage and Charlotte (Kristin Davis) attempts for a child of her own to accompany the little girl she has adopted. It's not hard to figure out where any of the plotlines will end up.

Doors open at 7.30pm and the performance starts at 8.00pm. Tickets are priced at £5 with a concession of £4.00 for OAP (60 and over). Tickets can also be ordered by email liphookmcentre@tiscali.co.uk for collection and payment on the night. A bar will be open and a range of refreshments will be on sale.
